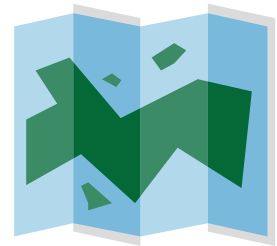
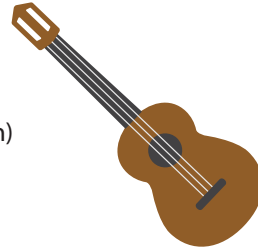
Bare Necessities...A Nude Attitude
